



## Casimir J. Bajgier

January 31, 1937 - December 26, 2020

Casimir (Cas) J. Bajgier, 83, of Chicopee, Massachusetts passed away peacefully at home on Saturday December 26, 2020 with his loving family at his side. Born January 31, 1937, son of the late Joseph and Martha (Misiaszek) Bajgier, he resided in Chicopee all his life. Cas was a 1954 graduate of Chicopee High School and received a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration from Western New England College. Cas also served his country as a member of the Massachusetts Army National Guard and he retired from Dow Jones and Company of Chicopee after 35 years. Cas was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus Bishop and Martyr Church. An active member in his early years, Cas served as past President of the Holy Name Society, the Parish Council and the St. Stanislaus Athletic Association where he coached the youth boy's basketball and baseball teams for many years. Cas also organized many baseball bus trips to Fenway Park for the Holy Name Society. Cas was also a member of the School Finance Committee and its Fund Raising Director. He helped organize the first of many July 4th polka festivals and dances which featured the region's top polka bands to benefit the school building fund. Cas was also past Scoutmaster for the Parish's Boy Scout Troop 131, a member of the Order of the Arrow scouting fraternity and recipient of the Chicopee District's Silver Spark Plug Award for service and dedication to the Boy Scout movement. An avid sports fan, Cas was a life-long Yankees and Patriots fan, including a Patriots season ticket holder for 25 years. Cas enjoyed playing cribbage at the Chicopee Senior center, summer vacations in Maine and Cape Cod and road trips to Foxwoods and Mohegan Sun. But most of all, Cas enjoyed going to his grandsons sporting and school events and loved being called Dziadziu. Cas is survived by his beloved wife of fifty-nine years, Joan L. (Stadnicki) Bajgier; loving sons Paul S. Bajgier and wife Nella, of Cromwell, CT, and Thomas M. Bajgier of Chicopee; cherished grandchildren Aaron and Zachary Bajgier and step grandchildren, Jonathan, Michael and Christina D'Amico and great grandson Matteo D'Amico; brother Edward Bajgier and wife Janice of South Deerfield, MA; and many nieces and nephews. Because of COVID-19 restrictions, funeral and burial services for Casimir were held privately for family. A celebration of life will be held at a future date.
