Alleen V. (Dudley) Augustus, 91, a lifelong Springfield resident, passed away on Tuesday, May 6 in a local nursing home. She was born on September 19, 1922, a daughter of the late Charles H. and Esther Mae (Rising) Dudley. She attended local schools and proudly served in the U. S. Navy during WWII, achieving the rank of Seaman First Class. Alleen was the first woman Commander of Hampden County District 3 American Legion Post 463, a member of American Legion Post 430 and former Commander for two years. She was active in the Golden Agers at Tri Towers, Chairman of the hospitalization committee which provided Christmas parties for the Soldiers Home in Holyoke, a member of the Honor Society, "Echelon 20 fi 4", and served as a Silver Hair Legislator, and Trustee for GAR Hall. She retired from the Springfield School Department as a cafeteria worker. In her free time she enjoyed life to the fullest, playing BINGO and various arts and crafts. She was the wife of the late William T. Augustus, who died on March 31, 2013. She is survived by two sons, Thomas of Three Rivers, and Francis of Springfield, two sisters, June Presslier, and Betty Belanger. She will be sadly missed by two grandchildren, Rachael Augustus and Christopher Allard and several nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her sister, Eleanor Asselin.
