CHICOPEE--Andrzej J. Gogol, 58, passed away peacefully on Saturday, February 4, 2012 at Baystate Medical Center with his loving family at his side. Born on July 28, 1953, a son of Zofia (Tofil) Gogol and the late Aleksander Gogol, he resided in Krakow, Poland until emigrating to America and settling in Chicopee nine years ago.
