Anna (Miczewski) Przybyl, 99, passed away peacefully on Thursday, October 31, 2019 at Baystate Medical Center. Born September 29, 1920 in Ilnik, Poland, daughter of the late Kazimierz and Rozalia (Kopij) Miczewski, she has been an area resident since 1966. A communicant of Our Lady of the Rosary Church and more recently of St. Stanislaus Basilica, Anna retired from the Milton Bradley Co. after many years of service. Anna had many friends and an active social life which included attending Polish dances with her late husband Kazimierz and various social functions within the Uinitas organization.
