June 19, 1915 - October 26, 2016

Anne C. Jendrysik, 101, a longtime resident of Chicopee passed away Wednesday, October 26, 2016 at the Birch Gardens for Nursing and Rehabilitation in Chicopee. Born in West Springfield on June 19, 1915, and lived in Chicopee for three –quarters of a century. She was the daughter of the late Caroline (Kopec) and Jan Galus. At her 100th birthday celebration she attributed her long life to having spent the first 22 years of her life on the family farm. She attended West Springfield High School. Her first job was at the Milton Bradley Company in Springfield. A homemaker for many years -she raised three sons. Later employment was at the Conway Bedding Company and the Sherman Upholstery Companies both in Chicopee. She was a bakery clerk at the Coffee Kup in Springfield -when she retired at the age of 82. Anne for many years was a volunteer at St. Stanislaus Parish, a member of the Rosary Society, a founding member of the St. Vincent DePaul Society and a charter member of the parish's Beautiful Years Club. Anne traveled extensively, not only to areas of interest in the United States, but to Poland, Rome, India and the Bahamas as well. She was predeceased by her husband of 38 years Stephen B. Jendrysik. Anne was predeceased by sister Nellie Pajak , and brothers Jim, Frank, Walter, Michael and Joseph, all of West Springfield. She is survived by her sons, Stephen R. Jendrysik and his wife Barbara of Chicopee, Richard S. Jendrysik and his wife Pamela of Salem, MA, Thomas J. Jendrysik and his wife Barbara of Longboat Key, FL ; cherished grandchildren, Mark of Grand Forks ,ND, Stephen of Sarasota , FL,
