Anthony “Tony” T. Lezinski, 70, passed away on Wednesday, November 8, 2023. Tony was a lifelong resident of the city, attended area schools, and was a communicant of Mary, Mother of Hope Church in East Springfield. He was employed by the City of Springfield, Dept of Public Works, for forty-one years before retiring in 2012 as an Assistant Deputy. Tony was also employed part-time for over forty years at the Eastern States Exposition. To his Big E family he was known as “Parker 2”. In his younger years, Tony coached soccer for the former East Side Athletic Association in which his girls’ teams won many division and playoff trophies. He was also president of AFSCME Local 3065, the Supervisors Union, for many years, and was a devoted member of the Marconi Club. He had been a longtime fan of the Yankees and NY Giants, and enjoyed watching any sporting event, especially NASCAR. Tony is survived by his two loving children, Rozlyn Sellen and husband Anthony, of Chicopee, and Michael Lezinski, of Springfield; his pride and joy, grandson Jayden; his former wife and a great friend, Diane Lezinski; and many cousins and friends.
