



## Antoni Wiczorek

May 30, 1948 - January 19, 2026

Antoni “Tony” Wiczorek, 77, passed away unexpectedly at Baystate Medical Center on Monday, January 19, 2026, with loving family at his side. Born in Borkowo, Poland on May 30, 1948, son of the late Kazimierz and Janina (Szulc) Wiczorek, he emigrated to America, on his own, at the age of eighteen. Antoni was hard working and wanted to succeed in life. Proud of his Polish heritage, he attended night school to learn English and supported himself. He began his career as a meatcutter at Falls Provision, followed by Big Y Supermarket, before becoming owner and operator of his own business, Union Market, in Springfield. Antoni was a devoted communicant of St. Stanislaus Basilica, and former president of the Knights of St. Stanislaus. He loved hunting and fishing, and was the former lake trout MA state record holder (22 lbs.10oz.). He was also a faithful member of the Chicopee Elks Lodge 1849, Swift River Sportsman’s Club, and Ducks Unlimited. Antoni is survived by his beloved wife of fifty-four years, Danielle (Bielski) Wiczorek; loving sons, Christopher J. Wiczorek, and Steven A. Wiczorek and wife Amy; cherished grandchildren, Audrey R. Wiczorek and Anthony R. Wiczorek; siblings, Stanislaw “Stas” Wiczorek and wife CarolAnn, and Regina Modzelewski and husband Andrzej; and several nieces.
