



Bertha Guzek

June 15, 1922 - October 30, 2012

Bertha Guzek, 90, a lifelong Chicopee resident, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, October 30, 2012 at Mercy Medical Center, with her loving sister at her side. Born June 15, 1922, daughter of the late John and Agnes (Sadej) Guzek, she was educated in Chicopee schools and the Powers School of New York. Bertha was a draftsman for the City of Chicopee and owned and operated Guzek's Rooming House for twenty years. A communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop and Martyr, Bertha was a past president of its Rosary Society, past vice president of its Children of Mary Society, a parish CCD teacher, and a member of the St. Vincent de Paul Society and Secular Franciscans, Our Lady of the Angels Fraternity. She was a volunteer at the yearly Franciscan Garden Party in Granby, and as a parish pierogi maker. Bertha was a member of the Christian Women of the World and Catholic Women of the Diocese. She was a past vice president of the Polish Womens' Alliance of America, Group 317, and past vice president of Sigma Nu Epsilon. She volunteered at the USO Club, R.S.V.P., the Chicopee Senior Center, and enjoyed ceramics and handcrafts. Bertha was predeceased by her sisters, Sonia Kielb and Mary Jaszek and by her brothers, Stanley Guzek and Frank Guzek. Bertha is survived by her loving sister, Barbara J. Gazda and her husband Chester, of Chicopee and several nieces and nephews, and great nieces and great nephews. Funeral services for Bertha will be held Saturday, November 10, 2012 at 9AM from the Kozikowski Funeral Home, 565 Front St., Chicopee, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 10AM in St. Stanislaus
