Bogumil “Bob” Czajka, 72, passed away peacefully at home on Friday, May 24, 2019, with his loving family by his side. Born in Hahn, Germany on November 14, 1946, son of the late Zygmunt and Wiktoria (Krezelewski) Czajka, he lived in Chicopee for the past seventy years. Bob was a graduate of Chicopee High School, Class of 1964. In 1965, he and his parents opened Bob’s Bakery in Chicopee, a family business still thriving today. A US Air Force veteran of the Vietnam War, he served as a sergeant in a service request tracking system squadron in the Vietnam theater of war.
