



Casimir P. Holubecki

May 10, 1946 - March 25, 2026

Casimir P. Holubecki, 79, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, March 25, 2026, at Linda Manor in Leeds, with loving family at his side. Born in Burghausen, Germany, during World War II, on May 10, 1946, son of the late Peter and Patricia Holubecki, he was a graduate of Mater Dolorosa School and Holyoke High School. Cas was a US Army veteran of the Vietnam War, serving in the 336th Assault Helicopter Division (Thunderbirds). After separation, he enrolled at American International College, earning a Bachelors' Degree in Business and Accounting. He worked as an accountant for many years at area companies including Old Colony Envelope, Avery Dennison, and P&G Tambrands, and retired from the USPS in Westfield after twenty years of service. Cas was a parishioner of St. Stanislaus Basilica and a member of the Polish National Alliance, Group 711. He also held memberships in the Chicopee Tigers A.C. and the Chicopee Lodge of Elks 1849. He loved to golf, played a great game of pool, and enjoyed ice fishing and snowmobiling. He also loved visiting the Quabbin, where he spent many happy years with his wife and son. Cas enjoyed music and the arts, enjoyed playing his accordian, especially around the holidays, and taking part in Polish foods and traditions. Cas was predeceased in 2015 by his beloved wife Sandra J. Holubecki. He is survived by his loving son, John P. Holubecki and fiancée Christina; cherished granddaughter, Fiona S. Holubecki; brother, Joseph Holubecki and wife Carol; sister Hedy Holubecki; and nieces, Dawn and husband Scott and their children, Olivia and Sophia, and Amy and son

Simon. He was predeceased by his brother, Jan Holubecki.
