Daniel Appleton,(aka Apple), 71, passed away peacefully into the arms of his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Wednesday, July 17, 2019, at home with his loving family by his side. Born in Springfield on June 3, 1948, son of the late Wilbert D. and Elizabeth F. (Godwin) Appleton, he attended local schools and graduated from Technical High School in 1966 and later from STCC.
