



## Daniel J. Wunch

February 21, 1947 - May 27, 2015

Daniel J. Wunch, 68, a lifelong Springfield resident, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, May 27, 2015 at Baystate Medical Center, with his loving family at his side. Born on February 21, 1947, son of the late Edward and Josephine (Zaczek) Wunch, he was a graduate of the former Springfield Technical High School, Class of 1965. Dan continued his education at Springfield Technical Community College (STCC), and worked as a truck driver for Sweet Life Foods, retiring after thirty years of service. A US Navy veteran of the Vietnam War, he served aboard the USS Rexburg and the USS Frank Knox. He was awarded the National Defense Medal, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, and the Vietnam Service Medal with 2 Bronze Stars. Dan was a well-known artist and a handyman always willing to help others. Above all else he loved his family, especially times with his grandsons, with those times always including his treasured granddog, Copper. Dan is survived by his beloved wife of forty-two years, Marcia A. (Bartyzel) Wunch; his loving sons, David J. Wunch and his wife Christine of Enfield and Matthew E. Wunch of Enfield; cherished grandsons, Adam, Brandon, Carter and Eric Wunch; mother-in-law, Stella Bartyzel; and brother-in-law, Larry Bartyzel and his wife, Gretchen, and their son, Jon. Funeral services for Dan will be held Tuesday at 8:30AM at Kozikowski Funeral Home, 565 Front St., Chicopee, followed by a committal service with military honors at 10AM in the chapel of MA Veterans' Memorial Cemetery, 1390 Main St., Agawam.
