Edith C. (Saj) Noga, 97, passed away peacefully on Monday, August 15, 2016, at Heritage Woods in Agawam. Born on July 21, 1919, daughter of the late Paul and Catherine (Rygielski) Saj, she was a lifelong Chicopee resident and a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr.
