Edward F. Szela, 81, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, January 9, 2018 at Baystate Medical Center, with his loving family at his side. Born March 13, 1936, son of the late Franciszek and Bronislawa (Bernat) Szela, he was raised in Thompsonville, CT, and has resided in Longmeadow for the past forty-five years. A graduate of Enfield High School, Ed continued his education at the former Hampden College of Pharmacy, earning a Bachelor of Science Degree in Pharmacy. He retired after a forty-five year career as a pharmacist at Baystate Medical Center. A communicant of St. Mary's Church, Ed was also an avid sports fan, especially for New England teams, and greatly enjoyed gardening. He and his wife Jeanne were dedicated polka music enthusiasts, supporting various festivals and polka bands. In 1999, Ed was elected a director of the International Polka Association (IPA) and was actively involved in fundraising for the organization. In 2012, he was honored by the IPA with the Joe Jozwiak Award. In 2010, Ed was presented with the Citizen of the Year Award by the Ludlow Polish American Citizens Club, where he served as a board member and dance committee chairman. Ed is survived by his beloved wife of fifty-two years, Jeanne C. (Kurczap) Szela; loving daughters, Sue Szela and husband Rob Czech of West Springfield, and Sandy Congdon and husband Brad of Reading; cherished grandchildren, Sophia Mary and Chase Edward Congdon; and several cousins and dear friends.
