



## Edward J. Waryasz

June 11, 1918 - May 23, 2015

Edward J. Waryasz, 96, passed away peacefully on Saturday, May 23, 2015 at the Soldiers' Home in Holyoke, with his loving family by his side. Born June 11, 1918, son of the late Joseph and Antonina (Skokwicz) Waryasz, he was a lifelong Chicopee resident. A US Army veteran of World War II, he served with the 444th Signal Battalion and received the Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal with a Bronze Service Star. Edward was a retired inspector for the former Moore Drop Forge Co. and a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop and Martyr. In his younger days, he was a member of the Polish Falcons Drum Corps. An avid New York Yankees fan, Edward enjoyed supporting his grandsons in all their athletic activities.
