



Edward Francis Zimany

May 24, 1920 - October 11, 2020

Edward F. Zimany, 100, passed away peacefully on Sunday, October 11, 2020 at Holyoke Medical Center. Born May 24, 1920, son of the late John and Frances (Caban) Zimany, he was a lifelong Chicopee resident. A graduate of Chicopee High School, Edward was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr. He was a devout Catholic and prayed the rosary daily. He was a World War II US Army veteran, serving our country with the 779 Ordnance Co. in the European Theater of Operations. He obtained the rank of technical sergeant and was humbled by his experiences. Edward retired after thirty-five years of service at the Chicopee Post Office where he was supervisor of carriers. He loved his work and was a dedicated employee, not missing one day in his time at the post office. To keep busy after retirement he worked at Carroll Travel Agency in Springfield. He was a member of Chicopee American Legion Post 275. Edward was predeceased in 1995 by his beloved wife, Marie Annette (Chartier) Zimany, who was his world. He is also predeceased by his brother and four sisters. At Edward's request, a Mass of Christian Burial in St. Stanislaus Basilica and burial with Military Honors in St. Stanislaus Cemetery were held privately. 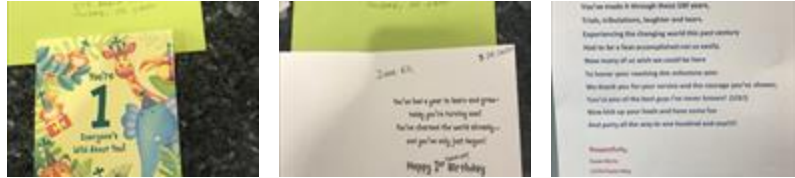
