Edward J. Znoj entered into eternal rest on Monday, June 9, 2014 at Baystate Medical Center. Born and raised in Chicopee, son of the late Jacob and Anna Znoj, he was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr. A graduate of Chicopee Trade High School and Coyne Electrical School in Chicago, Ed retired, after many years of service, from R.A. Turner Electrical Contractors of Springfield. A US Navy veteran of World War II, Ed served aboard the Aircraft Carrier USS LANGLEY as a Seaman First Class Gunner's Mate. He was awarded the American Campaign Medal, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal with nine bronze stars, WWII Victory Medal, US Navy Unit Commendation, Philippine Liberation Ribbon with two bronze stars and the Philippine Presidential Unit Citation. Ed was an avid sportsman, refereed high school basketball and was a basketball official for twenty five years as a member of IAABO Board 31. Ed is survived by his beloved wife, Cecilia A. "Ceil" (Guzik) Znoj. They were blessed with sixty-five years of happiness.
