



Eugene. L. Galuska

July 12, 1923 - October 9, 2017

Eugene L. Galuska, 94, passed away peacefully on Monday, October 9, 2017 at Wingate at South Hadley, with his loving family by his side. Born July 12, 1923, son of the late Jozef and Pauline (Dubiel) Galuszka, he resided in Granby for the past thirty years and previously in Chicopee. A US Marine Corps veteran of World War II, he was a survivor of the Japanese attack on December 7, 1941 at Pearl Harbor. His other battles and engagements included Roi-Namur Island and Okinawa Shima, and he later participated in the occupation of Japan. He was a member of the Pearl Harbor Veterans Group. Eugene was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr. He retired as a lab technician from the former Uniroyal Co., and enjoyed gardening and fishing. Eugene was predeceased on July 11, 2017 by his beloved wife of seventy years, Veronica R. (Maciolek) Galuska, and is survived by his loving children, Joanne Newcombe and husband Edward Jeffrey of Auburn, Gene Galuska of Agawam, Kathryn Barakat of PA, Michael Galuska of Granby, and Charles Galuska and wife Karla of Brookfield; nine cherished grandchildren and eight cherished great-grandchildren. He was predeceased by his siblings, Charles, August and Frank Galuszka, Nellie Sari and Phyllis Bury. Funeral services for Eugene will be held Saturday from Kozikowski Funeral Home, 565 Front St., Chicopee, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 10AM in St. Stanislaus Basilica.
