Eugene M. Gorski, 80, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, August 6, 2014 at Heritage Hall Nursing Home North. Born on August 8, 1933, son of the late John and Salomea (Novak) Gorski, he was raised in Holyoke and has been a Chicopee resident since 1958. A graduate of Holyoke High School, Class of 1950, Gene attended American International College and was employed as a distribution clerk at the Springfield Post Office for thirty years. After his retirement he worked part time for the Springfield Republican. Gene served our country with the 104th Air National Guard, 131st Fighter Squadron, from Barnes Airport during the Berlin Crisis.
