Frank J. McMahon, 87, a retired twenty-five year Springfield Police Officer, passed away peacefully at home on Friday, November 3, 2017. Born July 8, 1930, son of the late Arthur and Mary (McLaughlin) McMahon, he was raised in Enfield and graduated from Enfield High School in 1947, the same year he moved to Springfield. A US Navy veteran of the Korean War, Frank was a Chief Petty Officer serving aboard the USS Gallup, and was awarded the Korean Service Medal and the United Nations Service Medal. He later transferred to the US Naval Reserves, serving at the US Naval Hospital in San Diego, CA. Frank was a member of American Legion Post 275, Elks Lodge 1849, Moose Family Center, and the Eagles Club, all of Chicopee. Frank loved life and lived it to the fullest. He enjoyed cracking jokes and making people smile. He loved his Irish and Polish music. When you were with Frank, it wouldn't be long before you'd hear his favorite expressions, "Ya bettah believe it!" and "Who told you dat now?" He will be deeply missed. Frank was predeceased in 2009 by his wife, Irene M. "Tillie" (Krason) McMahon, and is survived by his loving children, James F. McMahon and wife Yelena, of Port Charlotte, FL, Nancy E. 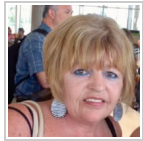
