



## Harriet A. Supernant

November 22, 1935 - March 26, 2023

Harriet Anne (Kusiak) Supernant, 87, passed away peacefully on Sunday, March 26, 2023 at Sixteen Acres Healthcare Center in Springfield. Born November 22, 1935, daughter of the late Harry and Anna (Strycharz) Kusiak, she was a lifelong Chicopee resident. Harriet was a Licensed Practical Nurse and worked for many years in area nursing facilities, retiring in 1998. A parishioner of St. Stanislaus Basilica, Harriet greatly enjoyed motorcycle riding and owned a 1960 XLH Harley Davidson Sportster. She was a member of the Ludlow Motorcycle Club, the Friendly Riders, winner of the Laconia Gypsy Queen Tour Championship and went on to be named one of the National AMA Top 10 Most Popular and Typical Female Riders for 1963. Her motorcycle is curated at the Harley Davidson Museum in Milwaukee, WI where it was, most recently, on display in the lobby for the month of March in celebration of National Women's Month. Harriet was predeceased in 2006 by her beloved husband, Earl W. Supernant, Jr., and in 2019 by her son, Earl T. Supernant, III. She is survived by her loving daughter, Christine A. O'Neill and husband Patrick, of Chicopee; cherished grandchildren, Maxwell Earl O'Neill of Chicopee, and Emily Christine Supernant and fiance Jon Bish, of Belchertown; and treasured great-granddaughter, Olivia Bish and her sister-in-law, Shirley Sagon of Springfield. She was predeceased by her brothers, Edward, Raymond, and Robert Kusiak. A Mass of Christian Burial in St. Stanislaus Basilica and burial in St. Stanislaus Cemetery were held privately for family.
