



Irena Kozikowski

April 21, 1919 - March 13, 2015

Irena (Chutkowska) Kozikowski, 95, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 13, 2015 at Holyoke Medical Center. Born in Poland on April 21, 1919, daughter of the late Stanislaus and Waleria (Skrodzka) Chutkowski, she had resided in Chicopee for over fifty years. A communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr, Irena worked at Super Brush and was also a member of Polish Women's Alliance, Group 422 of Springfield and Rycerstwo Niepokalanej. Irena was predeceased in 1990 by her beloved husband, Wacław Kozikowski; in 2011 by her son-in-law, Tadeusz Mazgula; and during World War II, by her daughter, Alicja Kozikowski. She is survived by her loving children, Mirosława Mazgula of Chicopee and John Kozikowski and his wife Mary of Brimfield; cherished grandchildren, Zbigniew Mazgula, Jean Richards and her husband Thomas, Christine Pereira and her husband Rayner, Dr. Tania Kozikowski-Nicholas and her husband Patrick, and John Kozikowski; cherished great-grandchildren, Jenna and Tara Richards, Neena and Anya Pereira, and Sophia and Farin Nicholas; brother Edmund Chutkowski of Poland; and many nieces and nephews. She was also predeceased by her sister, Maria Szulc, and two brothers, Marian Chutkowski, and Stefan Chutkowski, who was killed in a bombing raid on Lublin during World War II. Funeral services will be held Wednesday morning from Kozikowski Funeral Home, 565 Front St., Chicopee, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 10AM in St. Stanislaus Basilica.
