Joan L. (Stadnicki) Bajgier passed away on Thursday, August 12, 2021. Joan was born October 25, 1939 in Griswold, CT to her loving parents, Tadeusz and Anna (Kurpaska) Stadnicki. She was a 1957 graduate of Griswold High School and graduated in 1959 from Bay Path College in Longmeadow. Joan worked at Kaman Aircraft in Moosup, CT until her marriage to Casimir Bajgier on July 4, 1961 at St. Mary's Church in Jewett City, CT. She then worked at American Bosch in Springfield from 1961 until 1964, when she left to become a stay-at-home mom. Joan was an active mom taking her sons to the many sporting activities they played in the St. Stanislaus youth leagues during the 1970s. Later she worked at Elms College in Chicopee for seventeen years until retiring in 1998 to spend time with her husband, who had also recently retired.
