John C. Wilk, 91, formerly of Chicopee, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 28, 2012 at DCH Medical Center in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. Born in Lowell, MA on July 30, 1921, he was the son of the late Jan and Mary (Nawrocki) Wilk. John was raised and schooled in Lowell, Massachusetts before moving to Chicopee after World War II.
