



Kazimierz Barut

July 22, 1924 - November 13, 2013

Kazimierz Barut, 89, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 13, 2013 at Mercy Medical Center, with his loving family at his side. Born in Batorowka, Poland on July 22, 1924, son of the late Piotr and Zofia (Folta) Barut, he has been a Chicopee resident for fifty-seven years. A decorated veteran, Kazimierz served in the Polish Army, under British command, during World War II. He has served as secretary/treasurer of the Polish American Congress of Western MA, secretary/treasurer of SPK (Society of Polish Combatants), and vice-president of the Pulaski Club. He has received honors and awards for his membership and work in many organizations including, SPK, the Chicopee Falls Polish Home Association, the Polish Veterans Association, and the Polish Cultural Society of Chicopee. He was recently honored by the Polish American Congress and the Chicopee Falls Polish Home Association, and has served as co-marshal of the 2011 Pulaski Parade in Northampton. Kazimierz was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr and was a master electrician by trade. He retired from United Technologies Corp. (former American Bosch) after many years of service and then continued his trade in self-employment. Kazimierz is survived by his beloved wife of fifty nine years, Regina M. (Lublinska) Barut; his loving children, Leszek S. Barut and his wife Laura of Los Angeles, CA, Alicia H. Boothe and her husband Shane of Oregon, and Teresa S. Barut and Scott Cadieux of Easthampton; six cherished grandchildren, Kim, Karla, Kevin, John, Tim and Kylene, as well as three great-grandchildren; sisters,

Jadwiga and Emilia of England and Klara of Canada; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his brother, Walter Barut. Funeral services for Kazimierz will be held Monday at 9 AM from the Kozikowski Funeral Home, 565 Front St., Chicopee, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial in St. Stanislaus Basilica at 10 AM.
