Born in Krosno, Poland on August 25, 2007, daughter of Rafal and Beata Gazdowicz-Janusz, Kinga came to the United States in 2012, settling in Chicopee. She attended St. Stanislaus, Belcher and Litwin Schools. After moving to Westfield, Kinga attended Paper Mill, North Middle, and Westfield Middle Schools. She started this school year as a Westfield High School freshman. Kinga loved anime and watching favorite shows, especially with her sister. Her beloved dog, Lenia, was always by her side. Kinga is survived by her beloved parents, Rafal and Beata Janusz, loving brother, Mikolaj, and cherished twin sister, Patrycja, all of Westfield; paternal grandparents, Maria and Henryk Janusz, and maternal grandmother, Maria Gazdowicz, all of Poland.
