Leo P. Belisle, 87, passed away peacefully on Monday, November 7, 2016, at home with his loving family by his side. Born August 23, 1929, son of the late Frank and Corinne (Bonneville) Belisle, he was also raised by his late grandmother, Zephirina (Goulet) Bonneville. A US Army veteran, Leo served with Company A, 103rd Engineers, in the Army Occupation of Germany. In 1966 Leo earned a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting from Western New England College. He was fiscal director of Highland Elder Service Center, and financial director of the Springfield Action Commission. He had been associated with the Agency for Aging in Chicopee, was employed as a cost accountant for Tran Tex Corp., and performed auditing for the Internal Revenue Service. Leo also served as a field accountant for Ley Construction Co. A communicant of St. Anthony of Padua Church, he served the diocese as a CCD teacher. Leo was a competitive chess player, practiced Tai Chi, and enjoyed coin collecting. He wrote several poems published by various organizations, including the International Society of Poets and National Library of Poetry. Leo is survived by his beloved wife of fifty-seven years, Rita S. (Kulpa) Belisle; his loving son, Michael Belisle and his wife Betty of Chicopee; cherished grandchildren, Elisabeth Tabb and her husband Daniel of Ohio, Lee Belisle and his wife Rachel of Belchertown, and Ethan Belisle of North Stonington, CT; brother, Joseph Belisle of Deltona, FL; and several nephews. Funeral services will be held Saturday from Kozikowski Funeral Home, 565 Front St., Chicopee, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 1PM in St.
