Leslie Phillip Brodacki 79, passed away peacefully on Monday, November 23, 2015 at his home in West Hartford. Born in Chicopee on June 6, 1936, beloved son of Irene A. (Simoneau) Brodacki and the late Phillip F. Brodacki, he graduated from Assumption Parish School, Chicopee High School, and Pratt Institute, in Brooklyn, NY majoring in Architecture and earning his Bachelor and Masters degrees in 1959 and 1961. Les practiced as a licensed architect with firms in the Springfield and Hartford area. He also held the position of Planning Director for the City of Chicopee and as City Planner for the City of Westfield. Les retired from the City of Hartford Planning Dept. in 2003. He served on the West Hartford Historic District Commission from 2002-2012 while concurrently and passionately pursuing the restoration of his Victorian home. He was also an avid sail boater, pianist and a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop and Martyr. Les is survived by his beloved mother, Irene A. Brodacki, of Chicopee; his loving sister, Claudette I. Brodacki-Ravosa, of West Springfield; his loving nephew, Anthony W. Ravosa, Jr. and his wife Alysson, of South Glastonbury, CT; his loving niece, Mia A. McGeary and her husband David of Longmeadow; and six cherished great nephews. He was predeceased by his brother-in-law, Anthony W.
