



## Louis B. Covill

January 16, 1934 - April 8, 2020

Louis B. Covill, 86, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, April 8, 2020 at Baystate Medical Center. Born January 16, 1934, son of the late Louis J. Jr. and Louella (Benedict) Covill, he resided in Chicopee for most of his life. A communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr, Louis was a veteran of over thirty-three years of government service. He was a US Air Force veteran of the Korean War and then a federal law enforcement officer of the US Postal Inspection Service. Louis was a Hampden County Deputy Sheriff and a Chicopee Auxiliary Police Sergeant. He also served as past president and life member of the Interstate Police Officers Association.
