



## Mary H. Winiarski

July 19, 1939 - July 11, 2019

Mary H. (Kwarciany) Winiarski, 79, passed away peacefully on Thursday, July 11, 2019 at Baystate Medical Center, with her loving family by her side. Born in Zamosc, Poland on July 19, 1939, a daughter of the late Alphonse and Helena (Ternes) Kwarciany, she resided in Chicopee for the past fifty years and previously in Holyoke and Hadley. As a child, Mary, along with family members, were survivors of a Nazi German forced labor camp during World War II. She was the owner and hairdresser for Mary's Beauty Shop of Chicopee, and a communicant of St. Anthony of Padua Church, where she was a parish bingo worker. Mary was predeceased in 2010 by her beloved husband, Edward J. Winiarski, and is survived by four loving children, John A.
