Matthew T. Noga, 82, retired City of Chicopee firefighter, passed away peacefully on Sunday, November 6, 2016 at Redstone Nursing Center with his loving family by his side. Born October 31, 1934, son of the late Matthew A. and Stella C. (Strycharz) Noga, he was a lifelong Chicopee resident. Matthew was a graduate of Chicopee High School, Class of 1952, and furthered his education at Springfield Technical Community College (STCC).
