



Max J. Mierzwa

May 19, 1925 - May 21, 2017

Max J. Mierzwa, 92, a lifelong Chicopee resident, passed away peacefully on Sunday, May 21, 2017 at the Soldiers Home in Holyoke. Born May 19, 1925, son of the late Paul and Victoria (Krzyszawska) Mierzwa, he was a graduate of Chicopee High School. A US Marine Corps veteran of WWII, Max, a sergeant, served his country in the Asiatic Pacific Theatre of War, participating in the Max invasion of Okinawa and with the 3rd Fleet Operations in China. Max was a graduate of the UMass Stockbridge School of Agriculture, and retired after many years as the greens superintendent at Chicopee CC, a position he also held previously at Springfield CC. An avid golfer and traveler, Max was a member of the New England, American and National Greenskeepers Associations. He was a charter member of the American Legion Post 452 of Chicopee, and coached area youth sports teams. Max is survived by his beloved wife of sixty-six years, Ann J. (Sypek) Mierzwa; loving children, Peter P. Mierzwa and wife Laura of Shrewsbury, and Carol M. Hudner and husband Philip of Fairfax, VA; and cherished grandsons, Philip Hudner of New York, NY and Max Hudner of Fairfax, VA. He was predeceased by his two brothers. A funeral home service for Max will be held Wednesday, May 24, at 6PM in Kozikowski Funeral Home, 565 Front St., Chicopee, with calling hours preceding the service from 3-6PM. Burial with military honors in MA Veterans Memorial Cemetery will be held Thursday, June 1, at 2PM. Those wishing to attend burial services are asked to meet at the cemetery.
