



## Mitchell B. Bator

January 3, 1925 - May 2, 2017

Mitchell B. Bator, 92, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at Baystate Wing Medical Center, with his loving family at his side. Born in Wilbraham on January 3, 1925, son of the late Felix and Franciska (Dynak) Bator, he resided in Springfield for most of his life. A US Army veteran of World War II, Mitchell served his country in Okinawa during the Asiatic Pacific Theatre of War, receiving recognition for his marksmanship and campaign service. He retired after many years of employment from the Uniroyal Corp. Mitchell was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr, serving his parish as an usher, pierogi maker and member of the Holy Name Society. He was also a member of the Knights of St. Stanislaus Society and enjoyed golfing. Mitchell is survived by his beloved wife of sixty-nine years, Helen S. (Furman) Bator; loving daughter, Roberta "Bobbie" Bator of Springfield; brother-in-law, Alfred Furman of Springfield; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his six brothers and two sisters.
