Orrin Robert "Jerry" Miller, 83, a longtime resident of Chicopee, passed away peacefully at the Soldiers Home in Holyoke on May 6, 2016. Orrin was born Feb. 24, 1933 in Coopersburg, PA to the late Andrew and Viola (Ohl) Miller. A United States Air Force veteran, he served his country from 1952 to 1956.
