Paul H. Zajchowski, 76, passed away peacefully at Suffield House Healthcare Center on Thursday, June 12, 2025, with loving family at his side. Born January 13, 1949, son of the late Thaddeus and Irene (Midura) Zajchowski, Paul was a dedicated parishioner and usher at Holy Family Church in Enfield. A graduate of Northeastern University and the University of California, Berkeley, he earned his Master's Degree in Engineering/Materials Science.
