Peter C. Lemanski, 93, retired City of Chicopee Firefighter, passed away peacefully at the Sosin Center for Rehabilitation in Longmeadow on Tuesday, August 3, 2021, with loving family at his side. Born November 27, 1927, son of the late Paul and Veronica (Krzemien) Lemanski, he was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr. A US Navy veteran of WWII, Peter earned awards in ammunition handling along with the WWII Victory Medal. He retired as Lieutenant after a long career with the Chicopee Fire Department. Peter was predeceased in 2013 by his beloved wife, Helen G. (Grych) Lemanski, and is survived by his loving children, Kenneth M. Lemanski and wife Janice Pascucci of Winchester, Debra A.
