



## Phyllis T. Kos

Phyllis T. (Cichonski) Kos, 91, a longtime resident of Chicopee and winter resident of Sarasota, FL, passed away peacefully on Monday, June 4, 2018. Born Phyllis Theresa Cichonski in 1926, daughter of the late Michael and Salomea (Koczwara) Cichonski, she attended St. Stanislaus School and graduated from Cathedral High School.
