



## Richard E. Osienski

Richard E. Osienski, 91, passed away peacefully on Monday, June 1, 2020 at Baystate Medical Center. Born December 26, 1928, son of the late Anthony and Josephine (Such) Osienski, he was a Feeding Hills resident, having resided in Chicopee and West Springfield prior to 2017.
