



## Robert R. Findlater

February 2, 1947 - September 29, 2024

Robert R. "Bobby" Findlater, 77, passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 29, 2024 after a hardfought battle with cancer. He faced this battle head-on without self-pity, consistently hopeful and optimistic. Born in Springfield on February 2, 1947, son of the late Robert S. and Irene (Doyle) Findlater, he was a graduate of Classical High School, Class of 1965. Bobby was an outstanding hockey player at Classical, where he was a 1st Team All Western Mass pick his junior and senior years, setting the state record for goals and points in 1965. While in high school he was also an All-City pick for baseball in 1965. Bobby continued his education at American International College, earning his Bachelor of Arts degree in 1969, the same year his hockey team won the ECAC Division II title. Bobby was also a youth hockey coach for Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Parish in Springfield. From 1967 to 1973 he served in the MA Army National Guard, and was an avid Boston Bruins and Red Sox fan. He worked for the State Welfare Department and Conservation & Recreation Department, retiring in 2010. Bobby is survived by his beloved wife of nearly 44 years, Louise (Lapierre) Findlater; loving daughter, Jennifer Armstrong and husband Pete of Twin Lake, MI; two cherished granddaughters, Kate Armstrong and husband Adam, who are expecting their first child later this month, and Grace Armstrong of Ann Arbor, MI; caring sisters, Nancy Manning and husband Chris, Maureen Charron, and Peggy Shea; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his brother-in-law, Danny Shea.
