



Stanislaw Gladski

October 14, 1938 - July 14, 2025

Stanislaw Gladski, 86, passed away peacefully at home on Monday, July 14, 2025, surrounded by his loving family. Born in Cielesnica, Poland, on October 14, 1938, he was the son of the late Aleksander and Adolfina (Someniuk) Gladski. In the late 1970s, Stanislaw immigrated to the United States. He and his family eventually settled in Chicopee and he began working at Westside Metal Door Corporation, where he dedicated over 40 years of loyal service. Stanislaw was a parishioner of St. Anthony's of Padua Church. A devoted husband, father, and grandfather, he took great pride in his family. His grandsons, Stashu (who was named after him) and Max were the light of his world. He often helped take care of them in their early years and he cherished spending time with them. Stanislaw is survived by his beloved wife, of 47 years, Helena Gladski; loving daughter, Margaret Gladski-Lusignan, husband Nathan Lusignan, and cherished grandsons, Stashu and Max Lusignan of Southampton; sister, Jadwiga Kwiatkowska and brother, Witek Gladski of Poland.
