



## Stanley J. Fedak

April 11, 1926 - January 17, 2021

Stanley J. Fedak, 94, passed away peacefully at home on Sunday, January 17, 2021 with loving family at his side. Born April 11, 1926, son of the late John and Frances (Skrzyszowska) Fedak, he had been a lifelong Chicopee resident. A graduate of Chicopee High School, Stanley was a WWII US Army veteran, serving as a tank commander in the European African Middle Eastern Campaign. He served his community as a firefighter for the Chicopee Fire Department, retiring as Captain, after nearly forty years of service.
