Stephen M. Krol, 89, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, May 24, 2016 at Mercy Medical Center, with his loving family at his side. Born July 14, 1926, son of the late Martin and Agata (Misiaski) Krol, he was a lifelong Chicopee resident. Stephen was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr, and retired in 1993 from the Pratt & Austin Co. of Holyoke, after thirty-seven years of service. A US Army veteran of WWII, he served with Company C 3160th Signal Service Battalion in Central Europe and was awarded the Army of Occupation Medal, European, Africa and Middle Eastern Campaign Medal and the WWII Victory Medal. An avid outdoorsman, Stephen enjoyed fishing and deer hunting, along with being a member of the Lake Wyola Association. He was a member of the St. Stanislaus Holy Name Society, American Legion Post 351 of Holyoke, Polish American Veterans Andrew Balut Post of Chicopee, and a lifetime member of the Chicopee Elks, Lodge 1849. Stephen was predeceased in 2002 by his beloved wife, Jane L. (Winiarski) Krol, and is survived by his loving children, Christine A. Fedak and her husband John of Chicopee, Elaine M. Armour of Cape Cod, Stephen R. Krol and Lauren Ludwin of Chicopee, Beverly A. Cote and her husband Daniel of Chicopee, Nancy M. Simpson and her husband Marc of Chicopee and Darlene A.
