



## Thaddeus S. Wnuk

February 7, 1933 - December 23, 2015

Thaddeus S. Wnuk, 82, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, December 23, 2015 at Masonicare in Wallingford, with his loving family by his side. Born in Meriden on February 7, 1933, son of the late Anthony and Anna (Noster) Wnuk, he was a graduate of Meriden High School and earned an Associate Degree from the Culinary Institute of America in 1969. A US Navy veteran of the Korean War, Ted served as an electrician aboard the USS Albany and USS Worcester, receiving the National Defense and Navy Occupation (Europe) Awards. He was employed as a journeyman's electrician until 1967, a chef at the University of Connecticut until 1980, and an executive chef at the Hartford Insurance Group until his retirement in 1995. He was a member of the Knights of St. Stanislaus, Chicopee, MA and the Polish Falcons of America in Meriden, where he was awarded the Bronze Star and Silver Star for his dedication to the Polish Falcons organization. He enjoyed traveling and gardening. Ted was predeceased in 2013 by his beloved wife, Mary (Jendrysik) Wnuk, and also predeceased by his brother, Joseph Wnuk, and sisters, Helen Carabetta, Aurelia Wnuk and Frances Garneau. He is survived by several nieces and nephews. In respect of Ted's wishes, a Mass of Christian Burial in St. Stanislaus Basilica and burial with military honors in St. Stanislaus Cemetery were held privately.
