Veronica R. (Maciolek) Galuska, 92, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, July 11, 2017 at Wingate of South Hadley, with her loving family at her side. Born September 25, 1924, daughter of the late Julian and Veronica (Kozik) Maciolek, she had lived in Chicopee for many years before relocating to Granby. A graduate of Chicopee High School, Veronica was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr, and a member of its Rosary Society. She was active in civic and fraternal organizations and had been a delegate to Council 62 of the Polish National Alliance (PNA) for twenty-two years. She also held the office of financial secretary of PNA Lodge 2590 and was a member of its chorus. In 1981 Veronica was honored by PNA Council 62 as Polish-American Mother of the Year. Veronica is survived by her beloved husband of seventy years, Eugene L. Galuska; loving children, Joanne Newcombe and husband Edward Jeffrey of Auburn, Gene Galuska of Agawam, Kathryn Barakat of PA, Michael Galuska of Granby, and Charles Galuska and wife Karla of Brookfield; nine cherished grandchildren and eight cherished great-grandchildren; and brother Robert Maciolek of Chicopee. She was predeceased by her brother Everett Maciolek.
