



## Walter J. Krawczyk

September 20, 1923 - April 25, 2016

Walter J. Krawczyk, 92, passed away peacefully on Monday, April 25, 2016 at Wingate of West Springfield. Born September 20, 1923, son of the late Andrew and Barbara (Dragon) Krawczyk, he was a lifelong Chicopee resident. A US Army Air Corps veteran of World War II he served with the 342nd Fighter Squadron and fought in the battles of New Guinea, Bismarck Archipelago, Southern Philippines and Luzon. He received the Aerial Gunner Aviation Badge, Asiatic Pacific Theater Campaign Medal, Philippine Liberation Medal, Asiatic Pacific Theater campaign Medal and the Good Conduct Medal. Walter was a communicant of the Basilica of St. Stanislaus, Bishop & Martyr, and retired from Smith & Wesson after thirty-five years of service. He was an avid sports fan, a passionate golfer, and enjoyed bowling with his golf buddies. Walter was a longtime member of Southwick CC and previously of the former Oxford CC. Walter was predeceased in 2012 by his beloved wife, Evelyn M. (Lynch) Krawczyk, and is survived by his loving children, Carol A. White of Springfield and Walter J. Krawczyk, Jr. and his wife Nancy of Florida; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his siblings.
