William H. Kuta, 68, passed away peacefully on Thursday, September 11, 2014 at Baystate Medical Center, with his loving family by his side, after fighting a long hard battle with multiple sclerosis for many years and never once complained. Born in Springfield on September 24, 1945 he was the son of the late Zigismund and Jayne (Curran) Kuta. He was a lifelong Chicopee resident and a 1963 graduate of Chicopee Vocational High School. A veteran of the Vietnam War, he served as a sergeant in the US Army in Europe. In 1974 he established William H.
