February 13, 1923 - December 3, 2013

Zofia (Wojcik) Bernat Lemanski, 90, passed away peacefully at home on Tuesday, December 3, 2013. Born in Boleslaw, Poland on February 13, 1923, daughter of the late Marcin and Helena (Kowal) Wojcik, she has been a Chicopee resident for forty four years.
